Volunteer positions may vary in time commitment and responsibilities depending on the Director's creativity coupled with the availability of the volunteer. The positions marked below with an asterisk will typically require volunteers to arrive at the theatre one hour before each scheduled performance.

Set Design and Construction - Work with the Director to design, develop blue print and construct the set.

Set Decoration - Work with the Director to bring the set to life. Responsibilities vary per show.

Sewing - Provide costume alterations and on occasion make a costume or costume piece not readily available to the costume team.

Props - Locate, build if necessary and manage all props for the production.

Costume - Collaborate with the costume team in the selection, management and care of costumes during the run of the play. Collaborate with the sewing volunteer as needed.

Sound Design - Work with the Director to design sound cues for the production.

Sound Operation - Operate the sound board during the production.

Lighting Design - Work with the Director to design light cues for the production.

Lighting Operation - Operate the light board during the production.

Educational Programming - Work with the education committee in planning and/or attending after school classes or adult workshop series.

Summer Camp - Assisting in the programming and execution of Summer Camp- about 3 weeks in the summer.

***Concessions** - Provide snacks and soft drink service during pre-show/intermission and clean up the concession area at the end of service time.

***Usher** - Assist with seating of guests and assist with any theatre seating area clean up at the end of the show.

Graphic Design- This could be graphic design for any show, show posters, advertising, or even for scenic projections for our shows on our new LED board.

Hanging Posters- We print all of our show posters and hang them around town for publicity. This is a quick and easy way to make a big impact!
